We are very pleased to announce the first-ever Biology Club hosted by Birla Public School. We invite you to this initiative to become the thinkers of tomorrow. The Birla Biology Club (BBC for short) aims to provide a common medium for creative thought development and empowers young minds to hone their scientific and engineering skills in Biology and other Biomedical Sciences. Not only is this club academically rigorous, but it offers various opportunities for the first time to students here at Birla Public School in terms of:

- 1) Community Service works.
- 2) Hosting workshops for younger students.
- 3) Conducting various live seminars and interviews with experts from various fields.
- 4) Integrating Biology with Computer Science, and emphasizing the essence of Artificial Intelligence.
- 4) Integrating with other existing clubs to cohesively lead specific events.
- 5) Conducting advanced Biology presentations in the Birla Community.
- 6) Harnessing the art and filmographic skills Birla students have.

The Birla Biology Club is divided into 6 independent departments which are interlinked to systematically manage the events, interviews, and workshops:

1. General Events (GEs) (5 Posts available)

The General Events department's main role is to plan and lead events and activities the club wishes to host, which isn't based on any specific event theme. All forms of community service provisions would be dealt with by the GE department. Students who wish to work on a Biological Research project would also be under the purview of the GE Department.

2. Event-based Projects (EBPs) (5 Posts available)

The Event-Based Project Department is responsible for hosting events based on international and national observances. It would work towards organizing events like seminars, workshops, interviews, and the like, related to the topic, and based on occasions and occurrences.

3. Website and Blog post Management (4 Posts available)

The Birla Biology Club would be in possession of a personalized website, which will feature the club information, and among many other things, a blog post which would provide the opportunity to members to put out their literary works to the world and hone their creativity and literary skills. The Website and Blog post department will create content and manage the website and the blog. Members in this department would also be able to build their teamwork, web development, and programming skill sets.

4. Tutoring (4 Posts available)

The Tutoring Department will be conducting events of its own. Members of the Tutoring department would be responsible for managing the BBC Online Tutoring Programs. Here individuals who relish the concept of teaching others various short topics in Biology and Science can do so in this program. Individual club members from any department can also post short explainer videos on the Tutoring Dept.'s very own personalized YouTube channel.

5. Media (4 Posts available)

The Media Department would be responsible for gathering information about ongoing events, journalizing, photographing, video graphing, reporting, writing, and bringing awareness to our club events through the medium of social media and our website.

6. Design (3 Posts available)

The Design Team would be involved in designing, decorating, and constructing bases for events to be held in the club. The team would be involved in designing posters, social media posts, brochures, event venues, etc. We aim the design team to bring forth artistic inspiration to our club events.
